

Up North Orienteers (UNO) local orienteering event at **Pawtuckaway State Park** in Nottingham NH on **Saturday 20 May 2017**

**Schedule:**

- 08:00 Pawtuckaway State Park opens
- 10:00 Registration & Course Starts open and Beginner Instruction available
- 12:30 Registration closes
- 13:00 Course Starts close
- 15:00 Courses close, all participants back; start collecting controls
- 19:00 Pawtuckaway State Park closes

UNO fees for orienteering are \$5 per registration (with 1 map) for club members, \$5 per registration (1 map) for non-club members on WHITE or YELLOW courses, and \$10 per registration (1 map) for non-club members on all other courses. Additional maps cost \$2. Participants wishing to attempt a second course must register, but only need pay for additional maps.

An "Introduction to Orienteering" (beginner instruction) will be available upon request at registration. Groups are welcome. If you are coming with a large group (>10 people), please contact the event director (Paul Regan <paulregan AT usa DOT net>) to insure we have enough maps for you. If you are bringing youth (<18) that are not your children, please contact the event director so that we can send you the "Release, Waiver of Liability, and Indemnity Agreement" for you to have signed before you arrive.

**Directions:** Pawtuckaway State Park is well signed and additional orienteering direction arrows will not be placed. From Rt. 101 take exit 5 for Rt. 107. Turn right onto Rt. 107 north & go 0.6 mile. Turn left to stay on Rt. 107 and then quickly right onto Rt. 156 & go 1.4 miles. Turn left onto Mountain Rd. & go 2.0 miles to the park entrance on your left. Assembly area will be the swimming beach parking lot. From the park entry booth, it is about 2 miles to the parking lot.

New Hampshire charges entry fees for Pawtuckaway State Park: adults \$5 and children (6-11) \$2. Dogs are not allowed in NH state parks. All other state park regulations are in effect.
